Casinos are able to set the wager limits and maximum payoff amounts.

PokerTek recently unveiled its new [ProCore](#) electronic table game platform, and Blackjack Pro is the first game to be offered on that platform. Blackjack Pro with the Lucky Ladies side bet will be shown at the Global Gaming Exposition in Las Vegas on November 16-18, in PokerTek's booth #1210.
